Short Report of the activities of Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Jhargram during the period from 01.04.2025 to 31.03.2026

1. Monthly Programme at Jhargram Special Correctional Home

a) **Utthista Jagrata:** To spread the inspiring message of Swami Vivekananda among the students of the schools and colleges in the Jhargram district, we have been conducting a Value Education program called, 'Utthista Jagrata' for the last few years. **In the period, April'25 to March'26 of this year, we conducted this program in one college and 15 schools where 3219 students (Boys-1274; Girls-1945) and 128 teachers attended the program.** All the students attending the program were presented with a book of Swamiji worth Rs 10. A 2' Swamiji's laminated photo was presented to the institution along with a few books for the library. A documentary on the life and message of Swami Vivekananda was screened for the students. 3. Purchase of Land:

We purchased 4.2-acre land (equivalent to 12 bighas) at Mouza Pukhuria, bearing L.R. Plot No. 274, under L.R. Khatian No. 393, J.L. No. 739, Gram Panchayat Sapdhara, P.S. Jhargram, Dist. Jhargram from Mrs Shila Das of Kolkata at a cost of 27 lakhs. The land is situated at a distance of 2 km from the ashram.

4. Blood Donation Camp:

A Blood Donation Camp was organised on Sunday, 22 June 2025 at the premises of Ramakrishna Mission Vidyamandira (E.M.R.S), Jhargram. 46 people donated blood on that day. The program was conducted with the help of Jhargram District Voluntary Blood Donors' Forum. All the donors were given a certificate, book, tiffin and lunch.



5. Sister Nivedita District-level Yogasana Competition (3rd year)

A District-level yogasana competition was organized in the 8 blocks of the Jhargram district for the 3rd year from 3 June 2025 to 29 June 2025. The competitions were held in two categories, i.e., Age group: 8 to 13 years and 13 to 17 years. 10 boys and 10 girls in each category took part in the competition at each block (total of 320 candidates). All the candidates were given a participation certificate and a book on Swamiji, while the top 3 winners received medals in addition.

The top 2 winners in each category among boys and girls from each block (total – 64 candidates) contested in the finals which were held at the ashrama sabhangana on 29 June 2025. Revered **Swami Bhaktipriyanandaji**, Adhyaksha, Ramakrishna Math, Bagda presided over the prize distribution function.

Revered **Swami Madhavesnandaji** of the same centre, Prof. Suprakash Das, Seva Bharati Mahavidyalaya, Sri Jayanta Mukherjee (blood donor for 157 times), Secretary, Midnapore district unit, West Bengal Voluntary Blood Donors Forum were also present and gave away the prizes. Along with medals and certificates, the top 3 winners (a total of 12) received cash awards of Rs of Rs 2000, Rs 1000, and Rs 500, respectively.



6. Swami Vivekananda Tree Plantation Program (IV Year)

Tree plantation is one of the most effective ways to protect our environment and ensure a greener, healthier future. In the present times, when deforestation, pollution, and climate change pose serious threats to ecological balance, tree plantation drives hold immense importance. Keeping this in mind, we have been organizing Tree Plantation Program since 2022. The objective of this program is not only planting saplings but also instilling a sense of responsibility among the students towards nurturing and protecting them. Last three years, 13725 Tree saplings were planted at various places in the district. This year, we planted another 1265 trees during the period from 15 June to 15 August.



I. At Srirampur site:

The main focus of the tree plantation program was a 2-acre plot of degraded forest land besides our Srirampur sub-centre that was used as a Municipality dumping ground for some time. The site was cleared and made fit for plantation last year and 1300 saplings were planted, comprising of Sal, Mahogany, Shishu, Bakul, Jam, Sonajhuri, Arjun, Ashok, etc. **This year, we planted another 730 local tree species, mostly sal. Besides 150 fruit bearing and other species were planted at our new English medium school campus.**

II. At Ramakrishna Mission Vidyamandira (EMRS) campus:

Inside and outside our school campus 100 mainly fruit bearing tree saplings were planted by our students.

III. Saplings distributed to our students of free coaching centres:

Two saplings, one Mango and another fruit tree, were given to 200 students attending our free coaching centres at Chandabila, Odalchua, Srirampur and Auligeria in the Jhargram district. A small meeting attended by the guardians and students was organized at all the places and the importance of growing trees was stressed. The students were motivated to plant the trees near their houses and take care of them which will form a part of their all-round training. The following saplings were distributed: Mango, Jackfruit, Pomegranate, Lime, Sapodilla, Java Apple, Jujube, sweet lemon, Black Berry & Guava.

IV. Plantation at a local school

A Tree plantation program and a talk on the importance of protecting our environment was organized at Chandrika Chandra Sekhar High School (H.S.) on 26.07.2025. Nearly 400 students and 15 teachers took part in this program and 80 saplings were planted in the school campus.



7. Homeopathy Clinic:

Dr Ashoke Kumar Pradhan, a renowned homeopathic consultant conducted clinics on 10.05.2025, 14.06.2025, 27.07.2025 and 14.09.2025, where 30,26,41 and 32 patients were treated, respectively.

8. Swami Vivekananda District Level Cultural Competitions (IV Year):

A district level school cultural competitions were organised for the fourth year covering all 8 blocks and 1 municipality area of the Jhargram district from 18 August 2025 to 3 September 2025. The following competitions were held in 21 venues spread over the district. The details are as follows:

1. An Essay Competition on “**India’s Freedom Movement and Swami Vivekananda’.**” in 1000 words (For students of classes IX to XII).
2. Painting competition on “**Parivrajak Vivekananda**” (For students of classes V to VIII)
3. Poetry writing competition on “**Ramakrishner Naren**” (For students of classes V to VIII)
4. Elocution Competition on “One who loves all beings truly serves God.” (For students of classes IX to XII) – conducted in 2 blocks only
5. Quiz Competition (For students of classes IX to XII) – conducted in 2 blocks only



1102 students from 86 schools participated in the competitions, out of which 412 were boys and 690 were girls. All the participants were given participation certificates and a book on Swamiji. The details are as follows:

Total 43 students from 27 schools secured various positions in these competitions.

9. Youth Convention

To spread the life and message of Swami Vivekananda among our younger generation, a Youth Convention was organised at the Maa Sarada Sabhangan, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyamandir (E.M.R.S.), Jhargram on Thursday, 11 September 2025, celebrated as Universal Brotherhood Day to commemorate Swami Vivekananda’s speech at the Parliament of Religions, Chicago. **Around 400 participants (students & teachers) from 60 educational institutions in and around Jhargram town attended the convention.**

Swami Achyutatmanandaji Maharaj, a senior monk from Belur Math, Prof. Sushil Kumar Barman, Former Principal, Rani Indira Debi Girls College, Jhargram graced the convention and spoke on the life and message of Swami Vivekananda. Swami Vedapurushananda, Secretary of Jhargram ashrama explained the significance of Swamiji's Chicago lectures. All the participants were given a book on Swamiji and a photo and fed sumptuously at the end of the program.

10. Special Pujas

- Dashopachar pujas on Maha Ashtami on 30 September for Mother Durga and Jagadhatri puja on 31 October were performed in the ashrama. Nearly 125 devotees attended the puja on both the occasions and all were given Prasad in hand.
- Holy Mother Ma Sarada Devi Tithi puja was celebrated on 11 December 2025. Nearly 150 devotees attended the puja and had lunch Prasad.
- Swami Vivekananda's Tithi puja was observed in the ashrama on 10 January 2026. Nearly 100 devotees attended the puja and took prasad.
- Shivaratri was observed on 15 February 2026 with special puja and bhajans. Nearly 100 devotees and more than 200 students maintained fast and offered water on the Lord in the evening.
- Sri Sri Thakur's Tithi puja was observed in the ashrama on 19 February 2026. Nearly 200 devotees attended the puja and took prasad.



11. Winter Garments Distribution

We distributed 500 blankets at 9 locations in the Jhargram district among the needy people from 2nd to 24th December 2025.



12. Most Revered President Maharaj's visit to the ashram

Srimat Swami Gautamanandaji Maharaj, President, Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math visited Jhargram ashrama on 5th and 6th December 2025. During his stay, Revered Maharaj gave darshan to hundreds of devotees on both the days after Sandhya Arati. On 6th December 2025, he inaugurated the first floor of the Monks Quarters which was constructed with the financial support of Dr. Ashoke Kumar Pradhan, President, Institute of HYDT Research & Education, Kolkata. It was followed by a Sadhu Bhandara which was attended by 41 sadhus from 14 canters.



13. Scholarship

14. National Youth Day

National Youth Day was celebrated with a colourful procession by the students of our two schools around the Jhargram town. Revered **Swami Sumanasanandaji Maharaj**, Ramakrishna Mission Institute of Culture, Golpark inaugurated the procession from the ashrama campus. Revered Maharaj also led the procession for 1 km and offered flowers at the feet of the Swamiji Statue at the entrance to the Jhargram town.

A Youth Convention was held from 10 am to 2 pm to commemorate this day. Total 1650 participants from 50 institutions attended the convention. Revered Swami Sumanasanandaji Maharaj, Dr Akansha Bhaskar, I.A.S. District Magistrate, Jhargram, Smt. 15. GAP and Free Coaching centres

Ashrama runs 3 GAP units at Chandabila, Odalchua and Srirampur and a VAP unit at Srirampur with the assistance of our headquarters. Besides, ashrama runs two free coaching centres at Anandapally beside our ashrama (86 students) and at Ghitakham (54 students).



16. Book Store

Ashrama runs a book store from its premises.



17. Participation in Book Fairs

We set up an ashrama stall for selling our literature at the Jhargram Book Fair (7 Jan-13 Jan-26) and Jhargram District Book Fair (8 Mar-15 Mar-26). Books worth Rs 33,194/ and Rs 21,748/ were sold respectively at these fairs.

1. Opening Ceremony of the new School:

Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapith (Primary Section), Jhargram, the first co-educational English-medium school following the CBSE curriculum run by Ramakrishna Mission in West Bengal started its journey on Friday, 4th April 2025, with 160 students in classes I to IV.
